# Definitions



Any time in the past 12 months

Physical food shortages and/or worry about food shortages

In 2016,

- 12.6% of <u>households</u> experienced decreased food security<sup>2</sup>
- ~5% of households experienced <u>Very Low</u> food security
- 8% of households with <u>children</u> were food <u>in</u>secure (binary) (1 in 6 children)




Common among people with food insecurity<sup>2</sup>...

- Live at/near the federal poverty line
- Live alone or are single parents
- Live either within a principal city or in a rural area
- Are African American or Hispanic



HEALTH AND RETIREMENT STUDY A Longitudinal Study of Health, Retirement, and Aging Sponsored by the National Institute on Aging

- Based at the University of Michigan<sup>22</sup>
- Nation's largest longitudinal study of aging
- Participants aged 50+
- Survey every 2 years since 1990
- 2013: Assessed food insecurity via single inter-wave survey

## What data are available?

Two secondary analyses:<sup>23,24</sup>
1. Food insecurity & <u>Veteran</u> status
2. Food insecurity & <u>weight</u> status

#### (n = 8,073 respondents $\rightarrow$ n = 2,560 eligible men)

Veterans less likely to be food insecure, BUT FI male Veterans more likely to:

- Be younger (50-64)
   African American
   current smokers
- Have a lower income psychiatric diagnosis functional disability

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FI male Veterans more likely to:

- Be younger (50-64)
   African American
   current smokers
- Have a lower income psychiatric diagnosis functional disability
- Score as clinically depressed

#### Results: Weight Status...not significant...

#### **Results: Weight Status**

FI: All weight categories	FI: Overweight & Obese only
Non-White	Single/un-partnered
Hispanic	Any difficulty with ADLs
Poorer overall health status	Any difficulty with IADLs
Chronic lung disease	Any difficulty with mobility
Decreased word recall scores	
Current smoker	
Did not finish high school	
Psychiatric diagnosis	
Depression

Two 'snapshots' of post-9/11 Veterans: ~27% reported being food insecure<sup>25</sup>... but ~10% receive nutrition assistance<sup>26</sup>...

- Longest-running Military engagements in U.S. history
- Unprecedented polytraumatic injuries<sup>27-31</sup>:
  - Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
  - Post-Traumatic Stress (PTSD)
  - Depression & Anxiety
  - Suicidal ideation
  - Adverse long term health outcomes???



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
- Reintegration can be tough<sup>32-38</sup>...



#### Preliminary Data...in progress...

- Surveys + qualitative interviews
- <u>Reintegration</u> program for OEF/OIF/OND Veterans
- Vocation-focused horticulture

Some themes so far:

- PTSD & isolation
- Cognitive (TBI) issues
- Physical injuries
- Nutrition knowledge
- Camaraderie
- Finding <u>direction</u> and <u>purpose</u>



# Moving Forward

 Continue qualitative research → What questions need to be asked?



• Surveys →

What does food insecurity <u>look like</u>, nationally, among OEF/OIF/OND Veterans?

• Evaluations and Trials  $\rightarrow$ 

What are these Veterans already doing/seeking out? What else do they need? Who should be facilitating?

Longitudinal →

Does this change over time? Long term health outcomes?
