- A place to do data intensive Clinical Science Research

■ IS Not

- Does not own data (Not a data steward)
- Does not approve data access (DART)
- Does not provide software outside VINCI Workspace



- Comes in two variations
 - Standard Workspace
 - Development Workspace
- **Standard Workspace**
 - Standardized environment
 - Abundant resources
 - Software restrictions
 - No Administrator privileges
- **Development Workspace**
 - Special purpose usage (custom coding, use of non-standard software)
 - Administrator privileges




Standard VINCI Workspace

- Windows Server 2008 Enterprise R2 x64 Operating System
- No Administrative permissions
- Fixed software package
- 4 shared logical processors
- Shared 16 GB RAM (can request more)
- 10 GB H-drive personal folder (can request more)
- 100 GB project data folder (can request more)
- Tape and disk backup



Standard Workspace Architecture




Development VINCI Workspace

- Windows Server 2008 Enterprise R2 x64 Operating System (Undergoing upgrade to 2012)
- Administrative permissions
- Install additional software yourself (S-drive)
- 1 logical processors (can request more)
- 4 GB RAM (can request more)
- 10 GB H-drive personal folder (can request more)
- 100 GB project data folder (can request more)
- Tape and disk backup



Development Workspace Architecture



Analytic Software & Collaboration

- VINCI provides STATA, R, SAS, SPSS, MatLab, V3NLP, and other software
- The VINCI Workspace and shared Project Folders allow for national collaboration in a research group
- Can be accessed from outside the VA through CAG and Rescue - Handy for University collaborators
- VINCI does data security for you



VINCI SAS/Grid v9.4

- Load Balancing and Parallel Processing
- Support for large SAS Community
- Reuse of existing SAS Programs
- Small learning curve
- Availability/Automatic Failover
- Less downtime = more research
- Easy Administration
- Several Consultants available for help and support to users

SAS Enterprise Guide v6.1

- Standard for coding and Grid Access
- Enhanced and automatic features
- Easy to Configure and Use
- Wizards for any function
- Able to develop SQL Pass-Through Queries (recommended for the DB)
