Funding Opportunity: TeleHealth Research and Innovation for Veterans with Cancer (THRIVE) Associate Investigator Program RFA

The TeleHealth Research and Innovation for Veterans with Cancer (THRIVE) center (PIs: Drs. Scott Sherman Danil Makarov of the VA NYH HCS and Dr. Leah Zullig of the Durham VA ADAPT COIN) recently released its second Associate Investigator Program RFA. This training program includes ~25k in *FY24* funding for early career investigators (pre-major award such as CDA, R01, K) and an extensive mentorship and foundational curriculum in

areas of teleoncology and health equity research. Applications are due June 5th at 11:59 PM EST and are relatively brief and straightforward – please see the RFA PDF attached to the May Newsletter email for details. Applicants with a mentor with funded research at the VA will be preferred. May 9 & 10 TeleBehavioral Health Summit: Emerging Challenges and Innovations in Virtual Care

The TeleBehavioral Health (TeleBH) Summit is a free two-day, CME-accredited virtual conference, solely focused on today's emerging topics in digital and TeleBehavioral Health care. Building on the Behavioral Health Institute's TeleBH Training series, the Summit brings together national subject matter experts and thought leaders to address the challenges and innovations in the new digital landscape brought on by the dramatic changes caused by the COVID public health emergency, which will be lifted on May 11, 2023.

Though the Summit is not an official VA training program, many lead speakers are from the VA. It is also free, has affordable CME for most professions, and will not promote any commercial products.
