



# Disclosure & Privacy Protections

#### Informed Consent


- Full disclosure
  - List of devices with full descriptions of each
  - Data syncing via what technologies (e.g., Fibit Connect software, Vibrent app, Fitbit servers)
  - Electronic data storage: outside the VA firewall
    - Multiple Locations: Each is described
  - Transmission of data
  - Technical issues
  - Risks
  - Protections in place




### The Power of Informed Consent

- Aligning Terms & Conditions with informed consent






### Market Place v Research Pace

Develop Statement of Work (SOW)


6500.6 Security Checklist Completed

- **SOW** submitted to Contracting
- Sole source justification rejected.
- Several rounds of questions from vendors

Vibrent is awarded contract

Mar 2016




### Considerations for Mobile Device Vendor Selection...

- What is a mobile device/how defined?
  - Laptops, USB/flash, smartphones, tablets
- Questions to ask yourself:
  - Sensitivity of responses being solicited?
  - Equipment needed: VA, affiliate, subject owned?

# Regulation of Mobile Devices in VA Research...

- Policies that guide our thinking when planning for use of mobile devices:
  - VA HB 6500
  - VHA HB 7002
- Network Access, VA Data, Encryption
- Inventory, Data Storage and Destruction

Qualtrics commits to FedRAMPX

• Sole-source justification developed

Nov 2014

Jul 2014

Sole Source submitted to Contracting

May 2015

Intermediary Contractor awarded/signed service contract for Qualtrics

Oct 2015

Dec 2015

Informed that background checks required for everyone at intermediary vendor Nov 2015

Solution: name 2 Qualtrics employees

- background checks
- authorized to work on SS project.

May 2

Informed that PIV Cards required

Joe Holston contacted network ISO to remove PIV Card requirement

Jun 2016

Qualtrics approved to start work

Sep 2016

## Considerations When Evaluating Technologies...

- Method of survey: how are users providing responses?
- Data class?
  - de-identified
  - Coded
  - consented
- Data Sensitivity?
- Privacy and data protection requirements as mandated by policy?
- Prior vetting?
  - Service Catalogue
  - FedRAMP, etc

### Contracting & Purchasing

### Vendors MUST be in "SAM" system

- System for Award Management
- Get "solid" representative from the Vendor before contracting

#### Service v "Goods" contracts

- Be careful to specify in your Budget Justification
  - TYPE of contract
- Blanket purchase agreements

### Work with your local contracting officer representatives

- And get "checklist" of process AHEAD of time
- Research Acquisition Center: South Atlantic Office (Pittsburgh, PA)
  - Research focused

### IRB Approval Process

Intent to Fund Notification

Mar 2013

cIRB advice: submit with full waivers of informed consent and HIPAA authorization

Apr 2013

cIRB application Submitted

Dec 2013

3 rounds: cIRB questions & responses

Dec 2013 - May 2014

Informed that full committee review required

May 2014

- Data Banking and HPAA authorization are needed
- to support CREATE Projects
- 4th round of questions/issues

Jun 2014

#### Contingent approval

LSI application process begins with 3 research centers

Aug-Nov 2014

#### cIRB approves application.

- No Data Banking authorization necessary.
- IRB PO agrees to online HIPAA authorization

Sep 2014

#### Amendments 1 & 2

- Change in device/solution
- Change in PI

May-Dec 2015

#### Amendment 3

Change baseline survey & recruiting

Nov 2015-Jan 2016

#### Amendment 4

Intervention details and content

Apr-Jun 2017

#### Amendment 5

Revisions based on UAT

Aug-Sep 2017

#### Amendment 6

Change in Follow-up surveys

Jan-Mar 2018
