

# VINCI

The VA Informatics and Computing Infrastructure (VINCI) is a major informatics initiative of the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) that provides a secure, central analytic platform for performing research and supporting clinical operations activities. It is a partnership between the VA Office of Information Technology (OI&T) and the Veterans Health Administration Office of Research and Development (VHA ORD). VINCI includes a cluster of servers for securely hosting suites of databases integrated from select national VA data sources.





# DATA in VINCI

VINCI has data on more than 22 million patients receiving care at over 1,400 medical centers, outpatient clinics, nursing homes, and domiciliaries. Most data originates from the extensively used Veterans Health Information Systems and Technology Architecture (VistA), the VA electronic medical record system.

# Feasibility

- Feasibilities provide aggregate counts for researchers during **the preparatory to research phase**. The deliverables result in descriptive statistics and summarized counts to assist in grant and IRB applications.
- Feasibilities help to understand **cohort size and structure**
- Feasibilities help to understand **impact of each criteria to cohort size and structure**
- Feasibilities result **cannot** be used for any publication
- **No regulatory documents** are required





# Feasibility

## Inclusion/exclusion criteria

- Location (nationwide or some specific location)
- Time frame
- Age/gender/other limitation
- Diagnosis (ICD9\*/10 codes (\*VA uses ICD10 codes since October 2015. If time frame more than 3 years, please, provide both))
- Procedures (CPT codes or/and ICD-PC)
- Lab test. (topography, units, range)
- Medications (list of all generic and brand names, strength and route of administration)

## Break downs

- Locations
- Time periods
- Age groups
- BMI groups
- Race
- Etc.

# Data Needs Assessment (DNA)

VINCI Services supports VA research by assisting customers with Data Needs questions (DNA) relating to the VA Corporate Data Warehouse (CDW) and other VA data sources.

These questions range from

- ✓ data availability
- ✓ data location
- ✓ data definitions
- ✓ assistance with completing the DART application
- ✓ assistance with completing CDW-domain checklist
- ✓ assistance with IRB protocol preparation
- ✓ etc.





# Patients List

Electronic Medical Record (EMR)-driven recruitment support supplements traditional patient recruiting methods by leveraging patient data stored in the VA EMR

IRB approved prospective projects:

- Clinical trials (intervention: drugs, devices, tests, contact, etc.)
- Cohort studies
  - observational study
  - survey study








# Patient List Flowchart
