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

## Key Concepts in Distinguishing Non-Research vs. Research

#### Definition of "Research"

VHA Directive 1200.05(2), Paragraph 3. cc.:

cc: "Research means a systematic investigation, including research development, testing and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge. Activities that meet this definition constitute research for purposes of this directive, whether or not they are conducted or supported under a program that is considered research for other purposes. For example, some demonstration and service programs may include research activities. Clinical investigations, including clinical investigations as defined under FDA regulations in 21 CFR 50.3, 312.3(b), and 812.3(h), are considered research for purposes of this directive. . . . "

#### **Key Phrases: Simplifying the Words**

- Systematic investigation:
  - An activity that is planned in advance and that uses data collection and analysis to answer a question. Although research must include systematic investigation, non-research operations activities also include systematic investigation to ensure reliable outcomes. Systematic investigation does not, in and of itself, define research.
    - Source: VHA Program Guide 1200.21, Paragraph 4.e.
- Generalizable knowledge:
  - Information that expands the knowledge base of a scientific discipline or other scholarly field of study. Systematic investigations designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge constitute research.
    - Source: VHA Program Guide 1200.21, Paragraph 4.a.









#### Non-Systematic Activity – Traveling Without a Plan







#### What Are Examples of Non-Generalizable Activities?

- Biographies
- •Oral histories that are designed solely to create a record of specific historical events
- Service or course evaluations, unless they can be generalized to other individuals
- •Case reports of a single patient, two patients, or three patients is not generalizable





### **Key Characteristics of Non-Research Activities:** ORD Program Guide 1200.21: VHA Operations Activities That May Constitute Research

- Issued by ORD on January 9, 2019 that includes criteria to assist in determining whether a VHA operations activity constitutes research.
  - Replacement for VHA Handbook 1058.05 "VHA Operations Activities that May Constitute Research," dated October 28, 2011.
  - Establishes procedures for verifying and documenting the non-research status of certain operations activities prior to publication of findings outside the Department of Veterans Affairs
- Primary purpose of quality assessment and quality improvement for internal VA purposes.
  - The activity is designed and implemented for internal VA operational purposes (i.e., its findings are intended to be used by VA or by entities responsible for overseeing VA).
- Not designed for generalizability beyond VA.
  - The activity is <u>not</u> designed to produce information that expands the knowledge base of a scientific discipline (or other scholarly field).
  - However, this does not mean that a research activity done solely within VA is not research if it
    is only conducted within VA.





## Examples of Non-Research Operations Activities from ORD Program Guide 1200.21

Quality assessment and quality improvement activities designed for internal VA purposes, including routine data collection and analysis for operational monitoring, evaluation, and program improvement purposes.

- VHA system redesign activities, patient satisfaction surveys, case management and care coordination, policy and guideline development and related evaluation activities
- Competence or qualification reviews of VA employees and health care professionals, performance evaluations; peer review; training and education; accreditation

#### **Examples:**

- VA All Employee Survey (AES), Voice of VA Survey
- Cardiac Assessment Reporting and Tracking System (CART)
- External Peer Review Program (EPRP), RAPID
- Home and Community Based Quality Care Initiative
- Inpatient Evaluation Center (IPEC)
- Mental Health Program Evaluation Centers (e.g., SMITREC)
- VA Surgical Quality Improvement Program (VASQIP)
- VHA Quality Improvement Initiative (VQuIP)





## Activities that <u>are</u> Research & Require VA R&D Committee Approval and Any Applicable Committee or Subcommittee

- Any activity whose <u>conceptualization</u>, <u>plan</u>, <u>or implementation</u> is <u>supplemented</u>
   or <u>modified</u> in order to produce information expanding the knowledge base of a
   scientific discipline or scholarly field of study because it is a systematic
   investigation designed to develop or contributed to generalizable knowledge
- Modifying or adding to an <u>existing</u> non-research activity to produce information expanding the knowledge base of a scientific discipline or scholarly field of study as a systematic investigation designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge
- Analyzing non-research data in a different way or combining datasets to produce information expanding the knowledge base of a scientific discipline or scholarly field of study when the activity is a systematic investigation designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge





#### **Identifying Research Activities**

#### The following activities **ARE ALWAYS** Research:

- Activities funded or otherwise supported as research by the Office of Research
   & Development (ORD)
- Clinical investigations as defined under Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regulations

#### The following activities **ARE ALMOST ALWAYS** Research:

#### Activities using:

- Double blind interventions
- Placebo controls
- Prospective <u>patient-level randomization</u> to clinical interventions not tailored to individual patient benefit

#### **VA Electronic Determination Aid (VAEDA)**

#### What is VAEDA?

The VA Electronic Determination Aid (VAEDA) is a decision support tool created to:

- Reduce variability in regulatory preliminary determinations for proposed research, quality improvement, program evaluation, and innovation projects.
- Decrease administrative burden on research offices and IRB members.

The VAEDA tool intends to harmonize and standardize project (research/not research) classifications for all VA facilities.

**NOTE:** Research studies that are known to need an IRB review (clinical trial) or involve animals (IACUC review) do not need to go through the VAEDA process.





#### **How does VAEDA work?**

- Fully launched and available in all VAMCs as of September 2022, VAEDA is the validated enterprise solution for research determinations.
- VAEDA helps the project owner understand where a project should be routed for approval, since research offices and IRBs/RDCs have no authority to approve anything that is not research.
  - Project leaders can answer questions regarding their proposed project, and the VAEDA tool will, based on the logic questions answered, produce a preliminary determination
  - Preliminary determinations are intended to be provided to an approving authority (e.g., research into VAIRRS, not research to local process) to complete a final determination and move through the approval process.
- We need Quality Management to identify where not research determinations should be routed.
   Currently, >10,000 determination applications per year are routed to IRB chairs and >6,000 are determined to be not research

How many exempt determinations – 138

#### QUERI Non-Research Project Status

- QUERI projects are non-research projects because of the funding source (medical administration, or 0160 funds) and their focus on improvement within VA.
- Protocols involving data collection are non-research if the data are fed back to providers or operations leaders to directly improve care and/or other VA processes. The activity does not meet the definition of research.
- In situations when a QUERI project wants to collect additional data above and beyond what is needed for informing improvement within VA, a determination should be sought as to whether that part of the project's activities constitute research.

#### QUERI Projects and "Extra Data"

- In situations when a QUERI project wants to collect additional data beyond what is needed for informing improvement within VA, then a determination should be sought as to whether the project's activities constitute research.
  - In Program Guide 1200.21, this is called collecting "extra" data for systematic investigation to produce information that expands the knowledge base of a scientific discipline (or other scholarly field of study).
  - In contrast, data involving non-research activities are directly fed back to providers or operations leaders to improve processes in the VA.
- However, a research protocol involving extra data or other creation of generalizable knowledge can be "piggy-backed" on top of a QUERI nonresearch activity

#### Examples of QUERI Non-research Protocols

Maintaining Implementation through Dynamic Adaptations (MIDAS): protocol for a cluster-randomized trial of implementation strategies to optimize and sustain use of evidence-based practices for VHA patients

Hybrid Type 3 implementation trial evaluating impact of audit & feedback alone vs. audit & feedback plus ongoing team-based quality improvement support (LEAP) to improve uptake of 3 EBPs

#### Examples of QUERI Protocols with Elements of Research and


- Implementation and evaluation of the VA DPP clinical demonstration: protocol for a multi-site non-randomized hybrid effectiveness-implementation type III trial
  - > DPP intervention rolled out by the national program office (non-research)
  - > Patient, provider outcomes data ascertainment (research component)
- Enhancing Mental and Physical Health of Women through Engagement and Retention (EMPOWER)
  - Compare in-person, peer-led, or virtual Diabetes Prevention Program for women Veterans
  - Facilitating CVD risk screening and risk reduction for women Veterans
  - Tailored mental health collaborative care for women Veterans

All three involved implementation of evidence-based practices, but ascertained extra data on patient, provider, and organizational factors to understand implementation impacts

#### QUERI Non-Research Letter

- Describes how the project (and data collected during the course of the project) is designed for internal quality improvement purposes, as part of the agreed-upon protocol established with the VA operations partner
- Signed by the VHA operations partner affiliated with the QUERI project
- QUERI Central Office developed a template, which is posted on the <u>QUERI SharePoint site</u>




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
