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



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Project Context

- "Strengthening Cerner Implementation for Health Professions Trainees to Optimize Learning and Reinforce Veteran Care"
- Main goal: Apply a mixed-methods approach to understand an electronic health record modernization (EHRM)
- Site focus: Chalmers P. Wylie Outpatient Center (Columbus)
- Site Focus: VA Central Ohio Healthcare System (VISN 10)
 - 3rd VA EHR transition site
 - Go-live: April 30th, 2022
 - Outpatient services and same day ambulatory surgery








SCHOLAR Overview

- Health Professions Trainees (HPTs) play a key role in VA's care delivery
- VA educates more trainees than any other US healthcare system (~113,000/year)
- Residents and other health trainees have unique needs and require a focused EHR transition evaluation
- Rotations are:
 - Short
 - Episodic
 - Taking place at different stages of an EHR transition
- We need effective recommendations to support HPTs through EHR transitions

SCHOLAR Thematic Findings as Data

- Several found HPTs' EHR training to be inefficient and poorly tailored
- The EHR transition severely disrupted the process of granting EHR access to HPTs
- Delayed EHR access lessens the reliability of HPT contributions
 - EHR functionality issues result in less HPT contribution to clinical care
 - Attendings face their own learning curve
 - HPT data is harder to obtain and less reliable
- The transition to Cerner made VA less appealing to some HPTs



Reporting Up

- VHA is a learning system
 - VA aligns research with operational priorities
 - Collaborations: ORD, HSRD, and Office of Academic Affiliations (OAA)
 - HPTs comprise a key element of this collaborative ecosystem
- Evidence Act (2019)
 - Decisions are based on rigorous evidence and data
 - Systematic and rigorous collection and dissemination of evidence informed by diverse viewpoints and methods






- Aligning evaluation/research findings to operations provide recommendations
- -Uncertainty in translating data into practice improvements (recommendations)
- -No set of standards

Filling the gap through clinical & operational **partnerships**





- Produce data-driven recommendations
- Honor collaborative partner aims and expertise



Checklist of Needs

Project Specific Needs

- Format transferrable to later project site iterations
- Capture recommendations that include contextual concerns and pragmatics to inform iterations
- Bring in operational/clinical partners
- Ensure format is not redundant with data collection processes

Program Specific Needs

- Format transferrable to other projects
- Ensure format is not redundant with data collection processes – value added
- Integrate evaluators, researchers, operations, and clinicians



Integrating Focus Groups




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Steps

- Identify participants: diverse group of participants
 - Include decision makers, operational partners
 - Include leadership to front line
 - Interview guide: Develop interview guide that is focus on recommendations and Idea generating
- Focus group
 - Task-oriented recommendations share via email
 - Foster exchange: Real time triangulation and corroboration of ideas









Thematic Recommendations

- Facilitating Day 1 Access:
 - Onboarding: shaped by sites
 - Establishing Facility Trainee Onboarding Coordinator
- Best practices sharing:
 - Centralize artifacts, actively promote solutions across sites
- Need for higher-level body to address issues:
 - Establishment of HPT Education Council
- Persisting issues:
 - HPT credit
 - Documenting preceptor workload
 - Running reports for Congress on HPT workload



Lessons Learned



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What Went Well

- Participants:
 - -referred to other participants to comment more
 - -clarified points being made by others
 - -reflected on others input
 - -improved credibility of the data
- Platform for participants to have their voices heard
- Participants thanked us for the "therapy session"


