


VA-Purchased Community Care Overview



Overview: What is VA-Purchased Community Care?

- VA-purchased Care: care paid for by the VA but delivered by providers outside a VA facility
 - The Office of Integrated Veteran Care (IVC) oversees VA-purchased care
 - Community Care (CC)
 - This care can take place in a multitude of settings
 - Providers could be VA staff at an academic affiliate, DoD providers, Indian Health Services/Tribal
 Health Program providers, or non-VA providers.
 - Family Member Benefit Program Care
 - Similar to CC, but not part of the contracts that drive CC
 - Often in same databases as CC
 - E.g.: Camp Lejeune FMP, Spina Bifida Health Care Benefits Program, etc.

- Consult sent to local IVC office
- Eligibility determined
- SEOC selected
- Referral created
- Authorization granted
- CC provider selected
- Appointment is made

Claim

- Appointment(s) occur
- Provider submits claim(s)
 - Institutional
 - Professional
 - Dental
 - Prescription
 - DME
- Claim adjudication

Payment

- Claim authorization sent to FMS
- Payment data sent to Treasury
- Payment sent to provider
- Payment reconciliation data sent to FMS and claims processing system

SEOC: Standardized Episode of Care

DME: Durable Medical Equipment

FMS: Financial Management System

 □ IVC Consolidated Data Sets Real SSN approval required
 □ Lung Cancer Screening Demonstration Project (LCSDP) Cohort

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

CDS Referrals Table

- Table name: CDS_Referrals_Fact
- Date range: referrals created FY 2018 forward
- One row per: referral
 - Unique Key: ReferralSID
 - May see "duplicates"
- Patient Identifiers
 - PatientICN
 - PatientSSN



CDS Referrals Table Contents

- Type of care referral is for:
 - SEOC
 - CatofCare_Modality
- Referral Status
- Dates related to referral
 - To and From date
 - Accepted
 - First Appointment Made
 - Initial Care Given
 - Episode of Care (EOC) Completed
- Referring facility





Possible Research Questions

- How many Veterans were referred to the community for Mental Health vs VA?
- How long did it take for a Veteran to receive care in the community?
- How have referral patterns changed over time?
- How many Veterans were referred out to community care, but returned to the VA?



Tips on Using CDS Referrals Data

- Use ReferralCreateDate field in "where" clause
 - ReferralStatus, ReferralFromDate, and ReferralToDate have NULLs
 - Is partition key for data from RB03

```
from [VINCI_IVC_CDS].[IVC_CDS].[CDS_Referrals_Fact]
where ReferralCreateDate >= convert(date, '2022-10-01')
```

- ReferralStatus
 - In Process: "Approved", "Sent", "Accepted", "Accepted Retro", "First Appointment Made"
 - Referral resulted in at least 1 visit: "Initial Care Given", "Active", "EOC Complete", "Closed"
- Issues with some fields; consult the <u>Source Data Elements</u> document



Tips on Using CDS Referrals Data

- I'm seeing duplicate referrals! What should I do?
 - IVC and VSSC have done their best to remove duplicates, so any "duplicates" you see may accurately reflect the truth.
- Should I limit to [IsInActiveStatus] = 'Y'?
 - IVC generally does not use the IsInActiveStatus, but it depends on the type of data needed.
 - Won't capture rejected, denied, returned, etc. referrals
- Happens rarely, but if you see many NULL PatientICNs: wait a day to pull data.



Operations DOEx

- The DOEx from SQL52 will be decommissioned
- Groups using the DOEx should switch to the tables in the ivc_cds schema in CDWWork on A06

DOEx: Data Object Exchange

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

Which Dataset(s) should I use?


- Which claims dataset(s) should I use?
 - Need pharmacy claims: PIT_Archive + Fee
 - Need data FY19 forward <u>only</u> (and no pharmacy): ivc_cds
 - Need data pre-FY19 January 2023: PIT_Archive* + Fee
 - Need data pre-FY19 current
 - PIT_Archive* + Fee (through January 2023) AND
 - ivc_cds (February 2023 and later)

*The Office of Integrity and Compliance (owners of PIT) does not want reserachers using PIT_Archive data past FY19. However, given differences between PIT_Archive, Fee, and CDS, we have found it best not to use multiple datasets when using pre-FY19 to January 2023 data, and thus have recommended only using PIT_Archive and Fee. One must use CDS data starting in February 2023 as PIT_Archive data is not currently available during this period.

CDS Claims Table

- Date range: FY 2019 forward
- One row per:
 - CDS_Claim_Header: claim
 - CDS_Claim_Procedure: ICD procedure code
 - CDS_Claim_Diagnosis: ICD diagnosis code
 - CDS_Claim_Claim_line: claim line
 - CPT and Revenue Center codes
 - CDS_Claim_Line_ICD_Detail: diagnosis per line
- Patient Identifiers
 - PatientICN
 - PatientSSN





CDS Claims Table Contents

- Dates
 - Of care
 - Of payments
- Type of Care
 - Bill Type and Place of Service Codes
 - Revenue Center Codes
 - Procedure Codes (CPT and ICD procedure codes)
- Diagnoses
- Identify providers
- Care Cost





Duplication in CDS Claims Table

- FBCS + FEE
- FBCS + eCAMS
- eCAMS (rejected/denied) + CCRS
- Same PatientICN + Date + CPT, different station

Deactivated ICNs:

- Does not apply to VINCI provisioned data/ data on RB03
- N ICNs = 1,229 (as of 01/29/2024)
- Operations users should look at (S)Veteran.(S)MVIPerson



Tips for Working With Claims Data

How do I find [specific procedures, care types or diagnoses] in claims data?

- Investigate how topic is billed or identified in private sector,
 Medicare, or journal articles
- Look at AHRQ and/or CMS measures

- ER Visits: Place of Service Code, Revenue Codes, and CPT codes
- HCPCS II codes for medications given during visit



Tips for Working With Claims Data

Which claim type (institutional or professional) should I look at?

- Not all services have a professional and institutional claim
 - Visit to a chiropractor: professional only
 - Pre-op visit: (likely) professional only
 - Ambulatory Surgery
 - In ambulatory surgery center: professional only
 - In outpatient hospital: institutional
 - Inpatient stay: institutional (and likely also) professional
 - e.g., Anesthesiologist
 - But! Sometimes claims are "missing"
 - Sent to Medicare or private insurer
 - Not submitted (unusual)

Other CDS Tables and Contents

- CDS_CC_DimFacility: VA facility associated with referral or claim
 - One row per: sta6a/institutioncode
- CDS_Referrals_DimCatOfCareGroupMapping: Crosswalk to consolidated categories of care


CatOfCare_Modality	CatOfCare_ModalityGroup
HOME HEALTH OT	SKILLED HOME HEALTH CARE
HOME HEALTH PT	SKILLED HOME HEALTH CARE
HOME HEALTH RN	SKILLED HOME HEALTH CARE

- CDS_CC_DimPatientDemographics: Patient-level information
 - One row per: PatientICN
- CDS_CC_DimRace: dimension table for patient race

Next for IVC_CDS

- Revising claims tables to add additional payment variables
- Claim Payments
- Pharmacy data added to claims



Other Datasets of Use

- VA
 - Patient Identifiers: SMVI or Spatient
 - <u>SEOC</u> database: "allowable health care services" specific to a specialty for referrals
- Non-VA
 - NPPES
 - VINCI SAS Grid: cms_pblc libname
 - Contains x12 (taxonomy) codes for providers (individual and professional)
 - Berenson-Eggers Type of Service (BETOS) classification 2.0
 - Based off of HCPCs/CPTs




