ISRM Scoring Guidelines

Each application is assigned a single, global score to two significant figures (one decimal place, e.g., "2.2") that reflects the overall scientific merit and potential to improve health care based on consideration of the review criteria.

<u>Score</u>	Scientific Merit	<u>Descriptor</u>
1.0 – 1.5	Excellent	Exceptionally strong with negligible weaknesses, ready for execution as is.
1.6 – 2.2	Very Good	Strong, but with weaknesses that should be addressed in a resubmission.
2.3 - 2.8	Good	Some strengths, but also key weaknesses that require re-working.
2.9 – 3.4	Fair	One or more major weaknesses that require substantial revision before resubmission.
3.5 – 5.0	Poor	Major weaknesses that generally discourage resubmission.
